You may remember that you send some *L. amethystina* to Lucie Vincenot already for our population studies... Now, our *Laccaria bicolor* population genetic project, shared with Francis Martin at INRA Nancy, vitally depends upon samples from Europe, USA and Canada: as usual, sampling is the key step. Your help would thus be more than appreciated....

Simply, 2-3 specimens (more than 3m away from each other) per population encountered is fine. Please record the approx. sampling site, and repeat this for as many populations as you can! All fruitbodies can be dried until sending (address below) ! ... and of course, I can pay for shipping/additional expenses.
